CONSENT ORDER

THIS CAUSE, coming before the North Carolina Board at its offices at 127 W. Hargett Street, Suite 304, Raleigh, Wake County, North Carolina, with a quorum present. The Board and Respondent agreed to entry of the following Consent Order.

1. Respondent is licensed as an architect by this Board and is subject to Chapter 83A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and Title 21, Chapter 2 of the North Carolina Administrative Code.
2. Respondent agreed to provide limited architectural services on various single family residences for Carrell Homes. Respondent submits that Carrell Homes designs and produces their own plans. According to the Respondent, Carrell Homes has an in house production department.
3. Respondent admits that he reviews the documents for accuracy and completeness prior to placing his architectural seal on them.
4. Respondent's action in placing his seal on said drawings is a violation of 21 NCAC 02.0206 (a) and (d) and 21 NCAC 02.0209 (6).
5. Respondent has indicated that he did not willfully violate Board rules.
6. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter by Consent and agrees that the Board staff and counsel may discuss this Order with the Board *ex parte* whether or not the Board accepts this Order as written.


BASED on the foregoing and in lieu of further proceedings under 21 NCAC Chapter 2, Section .0600, the Board and respondent agree to the following:

2. Respondent agrees that he will comply with all Board rules and laws governing the practice of architecture in the State of North Carolina.

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
