THIS CAUSE, coming before the North Carolina Board at its offices at 127 W. Hargett Street, Suite 304, Raleigh, Wake County, North Carolina, with a quorum present. The Board and Respondent agreed to entry of the following Consent Order.

1. Respondent Lamson is licensed as an architect by this Board and is subject to Chapter 83A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and Title 21, Chapter 2 of the North Carolina Administrative Code.
2. Respondent offered services through the firm Lamson & Condon, Inc. on the Black Water Bunkhouse project in North Carolina. Respondent contends that he prepared plans for said project on or about February 2006.
3. Respondent Lamson's individual license was not issued until March 7, 2006.
4. Respondent Lamson failed to complete the licensure process for Lamson & Condon, Inc. prior to preparing plans for the project and as such it was not currently registered with this Board to offer architectural services in North Carolina in February 2006.
5. Respondent's action in practicing architecture both as an individual without individual registration and through a firm not properly registered with this Board is a violation of G.S. 83A-1, 83A-12 and 21 N.C.A.C. 02.0215.
6. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter by Consent and agrees that the Board staff and counsel may discuss this Order with the Board *ex parte* whether or not the Board accepts this Order as written.

BASED on the foregoing and in lieu of further proceedings under 21 N.C.A.C. Chapter 2, Section .0600, the Board and respondent agree to the following:

1. Respondent shall, within thirty (30) days from the date this Order is approved by the Board, complete the process to properly register Lamson & Condon, Inc.

2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$500.00 for practicing architecture in the State of North Carolina without the proper registrations.


