CONSENT ORDER

THIS CAUSE, coming before the North Carolina Board at its offices at 127 W. Hargett Street, Suite 304, Raleigh, Wake County, North Carolina, with a quorum present. The Board and Respondent agreed to entry of the following Consent Order.

1. Respondent Kligerman is licensed as an architect by this Board and is subject to Chapter 83A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and Title 21, Chapter 2 of the North Carolina Administrative Code.
2. Respondent firm Ike Kligerman Barkley Architects, PC offered services on projects in Asheville, NC and Rutherfordton, NC.
3. Respondent Kligerman failed to complete the firm licensure process for Ike Kligerman Barkley Architects, PC prior to offering services on the projects.
5. Respondent's action in offering architectural services through a firm not properly registered with this Board is a violation of G.S. 83A-12 and 21 N.C.A.C. 02.0215.
6. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter by Consent and agrees that the Board staff and counsel may discuss this Order with the Board *ex parte* whether or not the Board accepts this Order as written.

BASED on the foregoing and in lieu of further proceedings under 21 N.C.A.C. Chapter 2, Section .0600, the Board and respondent agree to the following:

1. Respondent shall, within thirty (30) days from the date this Order is approved by the Board, complete the process to properly register Ike Kligerman Barkley Architects, PC.
2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$500.00 for practicing architecture in the State of North Carolina without the proper registrations.


