CONSENT ORDER


THIS CAUSE, coming before the North Carolina Board of Architecture at its offices at 127 W. Hargett Street, Suite 304, Raleigh, Wake County, North Carolina, with a quorum present. The Board and Respondent agreed to entry of the following Consent Order.

1. Respondent is an applicant for reinstatement of licensure by this Board and is subject to Chapter 83A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and Title 21, Chapter 2 of the North Carolina Administrative Code.
2. Respondent held a license to practice architecture in this State issued based on certification ("Blue Cover") by the National Council of Architecture Registration Boards. On February 2, 2005 Respondent's Blue Cover was revoked. As required by 21 NCAC 02.0303 (a) Respondent's license to practice architecture in the State of North Carolina was automatically revoked on February 10, 2005.
3. On August 1, 2006 this Board received a copy of a current North Carolina telephone book advertisement in which Respondent is listed under the heading for architects. Additionally, this Board is in receipt of a listing on www.architectureweek.com where respondent is listed under the heading "Architects Directory" for the State of North Carolina.
4. Respondent has practiced using the names CMA Group and C. Crawford Murphy Associates none of which are currently registered with this Board to offer architectural services in North Carolina.
5. Respondent's action in practicing architecture as an individual without proper registration is a violation of G.S. 83A-1.
6. Respondent's action in offering architectural services through a firm not properly registered with this Board is a violation of G.S. 83A-12 and 21 NCAC 2.0215.
6. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter by Consent and agrees that the Board staff and counsel may discuss this Order with the Board *ex parte* whether or not the Board accepts this Order as written.


BASED on the foregoing and in lieu of further proceedings under 21 N.C.A.C. Chapter 2, Section .0600, the Board and respondent agree to the following:

1. Respondent shall be granted reinstatement of his license to practice architecture in the State of North Carolina by the Board.
2. Respondent will take action to properly register any entity or firm through which he offers or renders architectural services.
3. Respondent acknowledges that placement of advertisements offering architectural services when not duly licensed to do so are a violation of Board rules and laws.
4. Upon reinstatement of licensure Respondent will be placed on probation for a period of three years. Any violation of Board rules and laws during the probationary period will result in revocation of licensure.


