2. Respondent's conduct as set out above constitutes a violation of NCGS Chapter 83A and 21 NCAC 02.0209 (10), 21 NCAC 02.0903 (a),(b) & (d), 21 NCAC 02.0905 (a), 21 NCAC 02.0909.

Based upon the Findings and Conclusions of Law set out above, and in lieu of further disciplinary proceedings the Board and Respondent agree to the following Order:

1. Respondent's license to practice architecture in the State of North Carolina shall remain suspended as provided by NCGS Chapter 83A-11 until he until he submits an application for reinstatement along with proof of completion of 24 hours of continuing education earned within the previous twelve months.
2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$2,000.00.
3. Respondent shall reimburse the Board for the administrative costs incurred in this matter.
