CONSENT ORDER

THIS CAUSE, coming before the North Carolina Board at its offices at 127 W. Hargett Street, Suite 304, Raleigh, Wake County, North Carolina, with a quorum present. The Board and Respondent agreed to entry of the following Consent Order.

1. Respondent Schrader is licensed as an architect by this Board and is subject to Chapter 83A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and Title 21, Chapter 2 of the North Carolina Administrative Code.
2. In February 2007 the North Carolina Board of Architecture sent Firm Compliance Forms to all North Carolina individuals holding a license registration to practice architecture in this State. In an effort to ensure firm practice compliance licensees were required to indicate the name of the entities through which they offer and render architectural services in this State. Respondent Schrader submitted his form on March 21, 2007 and indicated that the legal name under which he practices is Schrader Design, Inc. He also indicated that Schrader Design, Inc. is a Professional Corporation of which he is an officer, director and shareholder.
3. The North Carolina Secretary of State lists Schrader Design, Inc. as a business corporation. Articles of Incorporation for Schrader Design, Inc. were filed on September 6, 2001. In an annual report for the fiscal year ending on December 31, 2005 the nature of the business for Schrader Design, Inc. is "architectural". This report is signed by Harry Schrader, President on August 31, 2006.
4. On June 9, 2006 Harry Schrader signed a Certification on a 2006-2007 individual renewal form indicating that he has read the North Carolina Architectural Rules and Laws.
5. Through a series of telephone conversations and written correspondence Respondent Schrader indicated that he offered and rendered thirty five projects through Schrader Design, Inc. Respondent Schrader contends that he did not intentionally or willfully violate North Carolina's Architecture Laws and Rules. Nevertheless, in lieu of further proceedings, Respondent Schrader has agreed to enter into this Consent Order.



5. Respondent's action in practicing architecture through a firm not properly registered with this Board is a violation of G.S. 83A-12 and 21 N.C.A.C. 02.0215.
6. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter by Consent and agrees that the Board staff and counsel may discuss this Order with the Board *ex parte* whether or not the Board accepts this Order as written.

BASED on the foregoing and in lieu of further proceedings under 21 N.C.A.C. Chapter 2, Section .0600, the Board and respondent agree to the following:

1. Respondent shall, within thirty (30) days from the date this Order is approved by the Board, complete the process to properly register Schrader Design, Inc.
2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$17,500.00 for practicing architecture through a firm not registered to do so in North Carolina.
3. Respondent shall reimburse the Board of Architecture for agreed upon administrative costs incurred by this matter.
