

## **Requirements Regarding the Use of Professional Seals and the Practice of Architecture and Engineering in the State of North Carolina**

In the summer of 2002 then Board of Architecture Chairman Jeffrey Huberman invited the Board of Examiners for Engineers & Surveyors to join in establishing a joint committee made up of members of each Board. It was the charge of this committee to identify frequently asked questions and to clarify requirements regarding the use of professional seals and the practice of architecture and engineering in North Carolina.

The members of the committee included Frank Tyndall, P.E. and Henry Liles, P.E. members of the Board of Examiners for Engineers & Surveyor, their Board counsel David Tuttle and Executive Director Andrew Ritter. Board of Architecture members included G. Dan Knight, A.I.A. and Charles Boney, Jr. A.I.A., their counsel Noel Allen and Executive Director, Cathe M. Evans.

The result of their work was a laminated brochure sent out to all architects, engineers and building code officials. Their work did not include rule making, although the process generated some ideas for future rule revisions. Both Boards have endorsed the work-product of the joint committee as a non-binding interpretative statement explaining current rules and laws. It is the sincere intention for the committee members that you find this brochure, as well as the individual Boards' rules and laws and the NC Building Code, a valuable tool in your daily work.
